

Terms and Conditions

It is agreed that access to this website www.examinations.ie and the use of the on-line services provided through the website is governed by the terms and conditions set out below. These terms and conditions are important and are for the protection of both you and the State Examinations Commission (SEC). Please take the time to read them carefully. By proceeding further you will be deemed to have accepted them.

1. General

1.1 This website is established in Ireland in accordance with and is governed by the laws of the Republic of Ireland. When you use the site, you accept that your use of the site and any information on the site, will also be governed by the laws of Ireland and if any dispute arises from your use of the site or any of the information on it, you agree to allow such dispute to be heard in the Irish courts.

1.3 In the event of and in your transmitting material to the SEC using any of the on-line services, the SEC has no responsibility for the accuracy, veracity and completeness of same and for any errors in the manner of its input.

1.4 The SEC reserves the right to make changes to the information, design and services provided on the www.examinations.ie website without notice and without liability. Every effort will be made to advise of changes in advance.

1.5 The SEC reserves the right to add, amend or vary the terms and conditions of this agreement by publishing notice of such changes on its website and the continued use of the service will signify your acceptance of the changes.

1.6 You can only order (whether by post or online) a Certificate and/or Certified Statement of Results of your own examination results (See Section 4 below)

1.7 The Certificate of Examination Results Service and the Statement of Examination Results Service can only provide information that actually exists e.g. if a candidate did not complete at least one examination which resulted in a grade being awarded there will be no information to access.

2. Certificate of Examination Results Service

2.1 The Certificate of Examination Results service allows candidates to apply for their certificate of examination results where they sat state examinations in the years 2006 to 2011. Certificates of examination results for years prior to 2006 issued to candidates at the time of the examinations.

2.2. Certificate of Examination Results can only be issued once and cannot be replaced. If you lose or misplace a Certificate of Examination Results you can apply for a Statement of Examination Results.

3. Statement of Examination Results Service

3.1 The On-line Statement of Results Service allows users to request a certified statement of examination results on payment of the appropriate fee. The fee for a statement of examination results is €14.50.

4. Privacy/unauthorized requests

4.1 A Data Controller has important obligations under the Data Protection Acts and the SEC at all times uses its best endeavours to ensure that appropriate measures are taken to protect the security of a candidate's data. To that end the SEC has set up a number of security questions the answers to which are within the personal knowledge *of the individual candidate alone* and will not at any time be disclosed to any other party by the SEC. Accordingly, only a candidate who sat State Examinations is entitled to apply for a Certificate and/or Certified Statement of Examinations Results, and if any person other than the named candidate attempts to do so, SEC may report such breach to An Garda Siochana, and if appropriate, to the Data Protection Commissioner and the candidate.

4.2 Any person attempting without proper justification or legal authority to obtain a Certificate and/or Certified Statement of State Examination Results on behalf of another person may be liable to criminal prosecution and also to an action in damages in the Civil Courts.
