1. The project you submit for examination must be **your own individual work**, carried out in the school under the supervision of the teacher.

Your own individual work is intended to include the practical activities of making the model and compiling a folio.

Proof of **your own individual work** must be obvious from both the model and folio presented for examination otherwise marks will be lost.

Note: Where computer aided manufacture (CAM) is used, supporting CAD files/drawings must accompany the design folio to authenticate **your own individual work**.

2. A detailed Marking Scheme is included on this paper. Your teacher will help you to familiarise yourself with the Marking Scheme.
3. Read the Project Brief carefully commencing with the **Introduction**. Plan and present your individual project as outlined in the instructions given under the headings **Planning and Organisation** and **Project Manufacture**.
4. Your completed project consisting of a model and design folio, **both clearly identified with your examination number**, must be available to the visiting examiner.

Project Brief

1. Introduction

Make a **Model All-Terrain Vehicle** according to the example shown or according to an alternative design ***based on the example shown (Page 3 of 4)***.

2. Planning and Organisation (40 marks)

You are required to compile a folio detailing the following aspects of your work:

- (a) **Planning details** required before undertaking the task or alternative design details;
- (b) **Parts list** and **working drawings**;
- (c) Organisational plan, indicating the **manufacturing processes, materials and finishing treatments** to be used;
- (d) **Testing and evaluation** of the finished model including special instructions, if necessary, regarding the testing of the model by an examiner.

Note: Marks are awarded as shown in Marking Scheme (Page 4 of 4).

3. Project Manufacture (110 marks)

Special Note: Modified toys or recycled projects are not acceptable.

- (a) Using appropriate materials and processes make the model according to your plans which should include:
 - (i) An electrical drive for the model by means of an ON/OFF switch;
 - (ii) A rear storage unit.
- (b) **The use of bought-in electronic solutions will result in lost marks.**
- (c) All main operating features of the completed model to be **clearly visible without dismantling**.
- (d) The longest dimension should not exceed **350 mm**.
- (e) Electric power should not exceed **9 volts**.

4. Project presentation

Your completed project consisting of a model and folio, **both clearly identified with your examination number**, must be available to the visiting examiner.
